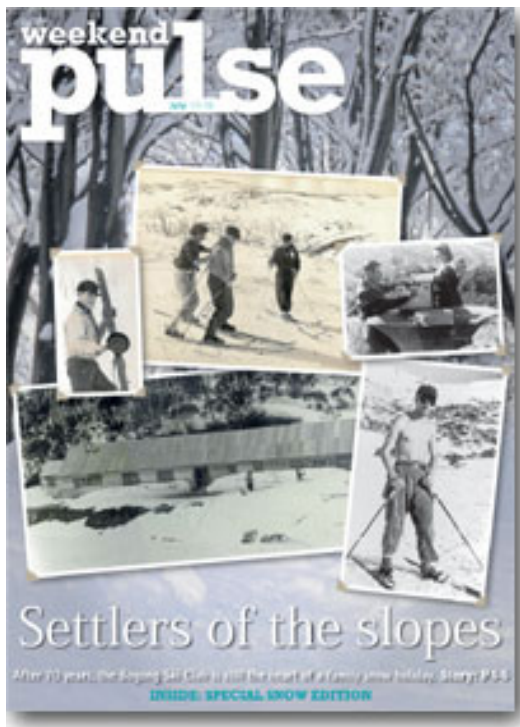


On Saturday the 17th of July 2010 Bogong Ski Club turned 70 years old.
